ALL ABOUT THE LOG BOOK:-

1. The log-book is a set of copies of signed reports enclosed in a folder or binder. The cover page of the logbook and its contents must be submitted to the FICCC Examination board as hard copy.
2. The Logbook should consist of two (2) sections:
 - I. Record of 50 cases
 - II. Record of courses and educational meetings attended by the candidate.
3. The logbook will be reviewed during the practical examination and carries 5 marks
4. Imaging performed before and after cardiopulmonary bypass i.e. during the same operation will count as one study for an ECHO study.
5. A study performed for the same patient on separate occasions may be counted as a separate study.
6. The report should have all patient identification data removed i.e. all cases should be collected in accordance with local requirements for data protection i.e. your patient confidentiality (privacy) purposes. No copying of logbook allowed between candidates of different.
7. All reports submitted must carry the signature of the candidate.
- 8. It is compulsory to carry the logbook during practical examination w. e. f 2016.**
9. In case of incomplete or no logbook the candidate will be disqualified.
10. A letter from the supervisor must be submitted with the completed log-book certifying that the studies have been recorded by the candidate and the signature of the supervisor in the logbook is mandatory
11. In case similar logbooks produced by two different candidates, both will be disqualified.
12. The different categories should be indexed with a page depicting “contents” in the beginning
